GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Grassroots Organizer for Planned Parenthood agency serving the St. Louis Region. Responsible for grassroots efforts to organize, empower and mobilize supporters to take action in support of Planned Parenthood's mission. Implement strategies and programs developed by the public affairs department in keeping with the strategic plans of PPSLR and the statewide public affairs team. Responsible for list building, outreach, volunteer recruitment and supervision through phone, crowd, door-to-door canvassing and on-line networking. Work closely with the Lead Organizer, VP of Public Policy, the director of the statewide project and other members of the Planned Parenthood public affairs team. Provide guidance to volunteers, interns and practicum students working on projects for which the organizer is responsible, and assist in administrative duties, fundraising, and special events. Required physical activities include: walking for up to 3 hours (e.g. canvassing, parades), periods of time outdoors in variety of weather (e.g. canvassing, parades, tabling, etc), lifting and transporting tables and boxes of materials for outreach work, standard office work (long periods seated in one place, on computer and phone)
