

PLANNED PARENTHOOD affiliates in MISSOURI 2009 VOTE CHART

Below, please find an alphabetical listing of members of the **Missouri House** with a selection of their recorded votes on legislation impacting the reproductive rights and health of Missourians during the 2009 legislative session.

For the Missouri House, there are three important votes recorded:

The '**2009 Abortion Restriction Act**' (HB46 & 434), filed for the second year in a row and died in the Senate would have:

- Prevented a woman from getting the required counseling from her own private or preferred physician by mandating she meet with "the physician who is to perform or induce the abortion" at least 24 hours before the procedure to conduct the informed consent process. This is a change from the current law in which "a treating physician" can conduct the informed consent process. It could also add days or weeks to the wait for the procedure if the physician is only scheduled one day per week.
- Created a new crime of 'coercion of an abortion' whether or not the woman actually sought and obtained an abortion.
- Required posting of signs in clinics that carried false promises of state-backed assistance in carrying a child to term and caring for that child once born.

An **Amendment to Protect Rape and Incest Survivors** from the burdens of the Abortion Restriction Act, which failed by a vote of 104-50.

The **Anti-Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) Resolution** sought to "express the General Assembly's opposition to the federal Freedom of Choice Act." While resolutions have no binding authority, they provided anti-choice legislators with another vehicle through which to speak against abortion. This resolution died in the Senate.
