In 2009, the Missouri Senate took few votes on reproductive rights related legislation. Below, please find an alphabetical listing of Senators with the most important recorded vote – the final vote on the Senate Substitute for the ‘2009 Abortion Restriction Act’ (SS HB 46). This substitute bill, which removed some of the onerous restrictions found in the House version, was rejected by the House and died in the Senate.
